

Mental Health and Wellbeing Policy

The purpose of this policy is for **Avondale Construction Ltd** to establish, promote and maintain the mental health and wellbeing of all staff through workplace practices, and encourage staff to take responsibility for their own mental health and wellbeing.

ACL believes that the mental health and wellbeing of our staff is key to organisational success and sustainability.

Goals

- To build and maintain a workplace environment and culture that supports mental health and wellbeing and prevents discrimination (including bullying and harassment).
- To increase employee knowledge and awareness of mental health and wellbeing issues and behaviours.
- To reduce stigma around depression and anxiety in the workplace.
- To facilitate employee's active participation in a range of initiatives that support mental health and wellbeing.

Scope

This policy applies to all employees of Avondale Construction Ltd, including contractors and casual staff.

Responsibility

All employees are encouraged to:

- understand this policy and seek clarification from management where required
- consider this policy while completing work-related duties and at any time while representing ACL
- support fellow workers in their awareness of this policy
- support and contribute to ACL's aim of providing a mentally healthy and supportive environment for all workers.

All employees have a responsibility to:

- take reasonable care of their own mental health and wellbeing, including physical health
- take reasonable care that their actions do not affect the health and safety of other people in the workplace.
- · accept opportunities for counselling when recommended

Managers have a responsibility to:

- · ensure that all workers are made aware of this policy
- · actively support and contribute to the implementation of this policy, including its goals
- · manage the implementation and review of this policy.

Communication

We will ensure that:

- all employees receive a copy of this policy during the induction process
- this policy is easily accessible by all members of the organisation
- employees are informed when a particular activity aligns with this policy
- employees are empowered to actively contribute and provide feedback to this policy
- · employees are notified of all changes to this policy.

Monitoring and review

ACL will review this policy in line with IMS requirements.

We will ensure that the effectiveness of this policy and the responsibility will lay within the boundaries of Occupational Nurse, Mental Health First Aider and Senior Management team. The policy will be assessed using measurements against and through feedback from workers, and a review of the policy by management to determine if objectives have been met and to identify barriers and enablers to ongoing policy implementation.
